For Your Prayer

- Pray for the country of Yemen. In Yemen, the ongoing war, humanitarian crisis and COVID-19 pandemic have impacted all citizens. Christians are additionally vulnerable because emergency relief is often distributed through mosques. Pray that secret believers would be able to support each other as they endure discrimination and persecution. Pray God will use them to raise up gifted, sacrificial leaders who are willing to follow Jesus, no matter the cost.
- Pray for COVID-19. Praise God for the QUAD groups decision to provide an extra 1 billion vaccines for the Asia/Pacific region. Pray that they may be delivered earlier than the end of 2022.
- Pray for Steve Logan and Laura McKay getting married on Saturday.

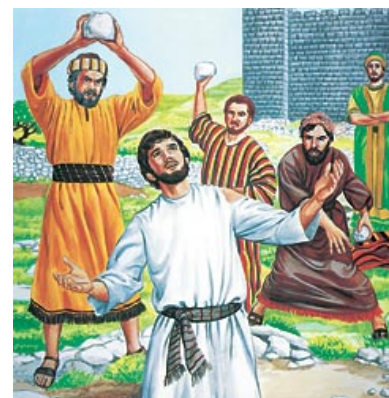

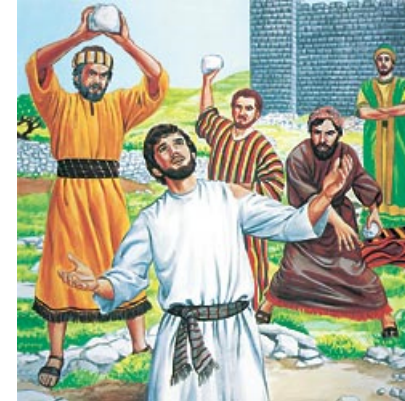
