Pray for wisdom for those who advocate for the rights of Christians, both within Iran and outside the country. Ask God to encourage believes who are isolated from other Christians.
- Pray for the COVID-19 response. Pray for the production of the Astra Zeneca vaccine in Australia. That will give us vaccine security but that it will also enable us to more generous to our neighbours in the Pacific and south east Asia.
- Pray for our Church. That we might make the most of Easter to talk to people about Jesus. That we will work hard to bring people to Church and connect with those who come to Church.


Kids' Spot
