Focus for April – Family Devotions

How do you start a family devotions with your children, here are some ideas from Sandy Galea (Kidswise)

- It's never too early to begin reading the Bible to children. From a very young age establish the routine Bible, bath, bed (or bath, Bible, bed).
- Establish a regular time when you read the Bible with your child (breakfast, dinner or bedtime).
- · Regular and short is better than irregular and drawn-out.
- · Use age-appropriate Bibles.
- As children grow older, encourage everyone in the family (adults as well as children) to ask one
- Be creative draw, dramatise or retell the Bible story. Use dress-ups, lego, toys, collage, paint, or playdough
