For Your Prayer

- Pray for the re-evangelisation of Scotland by a passionate band of believers. Pray for those plagued by alcohol, drugs and other social ills to be lovingly reached by Christians. Pray for the church to commit herself to Scripture-based spiritual renewal.
- Pray about the Parental Rights Bill (NSW). Pray that this bill will continue to move forward. Pray that parental rights will be protected and that schools will be banned from teaching gender fluidity to children.
- Pray for Scott Morrison. Pray for wisdom, strength and encouragement for our Prime Minister, and for unity within his party.
- Pray for post-COVID Church Life. There are growing reports of a significant number of churches who have witnessed a decline in on site attendance. Pray that the Lord's people would not "give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another and all the more as you see the Day approaching."
- Pray for post-COVID Personal and Family life. There are some who are unable to visit sick relatives or even attend funerals because they are not permitted to, or cannot afford to, leave Australia. This is a cause of deep sorrow and sadness.
- Pray for the Applebys. Pray for opportunities to meet and get to know new students, loving them as Christians by inviting them to Bible study but also making them feel welcome in Armidale and supporting them.
 Pray for wisdom about an opportunity to remain in Armidale next year.
