For Your Prayer

- Pray for the country of Nigeria. More Christians are killed for their faith in Nigeria than in any other country. The government's attempts to increase the influence of Islam across the country affect even Christianmajority communities in the South. Men and boys are particularly vulnerable to being killed and widowed women and their children have little protection. Pray for God's grace and comfort as many believers are displaced and experience trauma because of their faith. Pray the church will be brave enough to be a light in their nation and continue sharing the gospel.
- Pray for the COVID-19 response. Thank God for the easing of restrictions and the ability to meet and sing over Easter.
- Pray for our Church. That over Easter the good news of Jesus might be proclaimed faithfully and that through our Church services, radio programme and internet that some might hear the gospel of Jesus (and believe) that otherwise wouldn't hear.

For Your Prayer

- Pray for the country of India. Hindu extremists believe that all Indians should be Hindus. Converting to Christianity is against the law and those who do convert are under constant pressure from their family and community to deny Jesus. Christians are believed to bring bad luck into the community because they follow a "foreign faith". Christian women are often imprisoned or find themselves expelled from their families and forced to marry Hindu men. Many women who convert to Christianity are from the Dalit caste, the lowest of India's caste system. They are extremely vulnerable to persecution.
- Pray for the COVID-19 response. This time last Easter we were in lockdown. Praise the Lord that we were spared the worst of the COVID pandemic. Pray for much of Europe as they enter into a third wave.
- Pray for our church, that people might experience new life in Christ because of the message of Easter this weekend.
- Praise God for the work of missionaries all over the world. That while Christianity may be struggling in much of the developed world it is growing exponentially in much of the developing world. Pray for good training of pastors and church leaders to Church build from a solid base.
- Pray for those who have lost everything in the NSW floods. Pray for those who are exhausted after working hard to keep people safe. Pray for Churches in the flood affected areas that they may be hubs of hope.

Kids' Spot


