For Your Prayer

- Pray for Brazil. Of the 200 million people in the nation, 40 million Brazilians live below the poverty line. In Rio de Janeiro 20-25% of the city's population lives in slums called favelas. Within these slums hundreds of thousands of street children are trapped in drug addiction, prostitution and violence. Pray for spiritual maturity throughout the rapid growing evangelical church. Pray for the Spirit of God to transform lives within sprawling urban slums. Pray for missionaries to be sent to areas and roughly 130 tribes unreached by the gospel.
- Pray for APWM: APWM asks that all churches set aside Sunday 11th July as 'Indigenous Ministry Sunday'. We ask that on that day you pray for our Indigenous people that: God would continue to raise up and develop leaders for the Indigenous Church and that they would be well trained for the challenges they face, that the Word of God would remain central in the life of the Indigenous Church, that God would send His Holy Spirit and that many young Indigenous people would come to a genuine relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, that God would raise up workers for His harvest – Indigenous and Non-Indigenous, and that through the gospel there would be true reconciliation between Indigenous and Non Indigenous Australians.
- A Prayer of Thanksgiving: Save us, LORD our God, and gather us from the nations, that we may give thanks to your holy name and glory in your praise. Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Let all the people say, "Amen!" Praise the LORD (Ps 106:47-48).
