For Your Prayer

- A prayer from Psalm 125: "As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds His people, from this time forth and forevermore". This psalm looks forward to God's future protection; 'from this time forth'. We are not guaranteed an easy life. But whatever we go through, we are guaranteed that God will preserve us. Therefore we can lean wholly on Him.
- Pray for our National Cabinet. Pray for humility, wisdom, and unity as the leaders in the National Cabinet work together to make decisions that affect all Australians. Pray that God will work in the hearts of each State Premier and lead them to do His will.
