For Your Prayer

- Pray for Iran: Pray for comfort for Iranians, both in the country and around the world, who are hurting and grieving over what is happening in their nation. Pray for the church in Iran to declare with one voice, louder than ever, that "Jesus is Lord" and that truest freedom is found in Him. Pray for an end to the injustice and oppression perpetrated by Iran's government, and that all people in Iran would experience freedom through Jesus' resurrection life.
- Pray for revival: Ask the Lord to revive us. Ask the Holy Spirit to come and give strength and comfort to the weary. Pray the Lord would draw near to them and instill in them the hope of trusting in Him. We are prone to become hard – pray the Lord would make us soft. We are prone to despair – pray the Lord would give us hope.
- Pray for the Gilberts in Indochina: Give thanks that our workers have been able to all return to VN, however the process for getting long-term visas is still unclear for some. Praise God that the Gospel continues to spread among unreached groups in Laos. Please pray for Khmer Christian leaders as they prepare for the celebration of 100 years of evangelism in Cambodia.
