For Your Prayer

- Pray for Sudan: Since the 2019 coup, the situation for Sudanese Christians has somewhat improved, however social attitudes have not changed and the society is still majority Muslim and suspicious of any other faith. Trying to build new churches is very difficult and the government has not yet returned confiscated churches and lands, or put real protections into place for Christians and other religious minorities
- Pray for the homeless people in our suburbs: As their world falls apart, that they might find hope in a God who cares and a Church that expresses to them the love of God.
- Pray for Destiny Haven: That women who are needing help and support can find it in a supportive, Christian environment. That they can find a hope that is bigger than the troubles that are currently consuming them.
- Pray for Josh Montzka: Give thanks for good groups of friends and fun time in the city. Praise God that #Hack went well in Melbourne, and give thanks that "The Four" has launched and may already be seeing new believers. Pray that things Josh does can be emotionally filling and refreshing, and for inspiration and wisdom in creating ad campaigns for The Four. Pray for gentleness, grace, civil conversation and open heards for the Gospel while streaming.
