Building Pledges

Our pledge campaign has formally ended (but of course you can still pledge or give any time into the future). Currently we have received approx. \$200,000 worth of donations towards our Church redevelopment. We still have one pledge outstanding from 2021 of \$27,000 which will be paid upon the passing of the DA. In the last couple of months, we received another 18 pledges for approx. \$100,000. It was great to see the support from all aspects of the Church – the pledges ranged from \$300 to \$20,000. This brings the grand total raised/to be raised to \$327,000. Thank you one and all, for prayerfully considering this work.

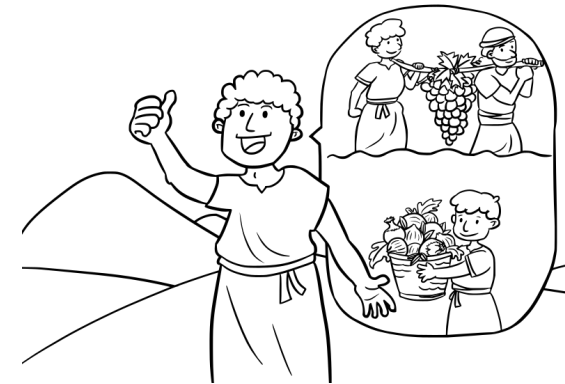
